Introduction:

Besides a diploma and degree in Hotel Management and Catering Technology, Maharashtra State Institute of Hotel Management & Catering Technology, Pune a State Government institute also offers a 3 Year Diploma programme in Travel & Tourism which covers all the basic operational courses /areas required to face the world of work in the travel and tourism industry. **The institute was the first one in Maharashtra to introduce a three year Diploma in Travel & Tourism in the year 1993, which is approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).** The institute got academic autonomy in 1995 and has equivalence granted by **Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education (MSBTE).**

The Diploma programme is industry centric where students are trained in different areas such as essential soft skills needed in the tourism industry like communication skills, customer service, as well as skills required at job which are locating places on world map, preparing itineraries, costing of a tour, booking an airline seat, filling passport and VISA forms online, etc and a foreign language. The students in their final Sixth Semester are given an opportunity to intern in their area of interest in travel agencies or travel related firms to help them understand the functioning of the tourism industry and thus making them more employable. Many of the ex-students of the institute are successful entrepreneurs while some hold top positions in well known multinational travel companies.
